

Common Planning Time @ 754X

Purpose: To provide collegial support for teachers each semester across multiple domains: instructional planning, inter-visitations, and looking at student work.

Structure of Professional Learning Cycles:

- Cycles run concurrent with 754X units of study. There are 6 units of study hence 6 learning cycles. Each learning cycle is 6 weeks long.
- Each teacher in a trio takes turns hosting a cycle as a presenting teacher for a full unit of study. This allows each teacher to receive high-quality feedback from colleagues twice in a school year.
- Feedback comes from design of assessment, grading policy, weekly plans aligned to the Framework for Teaching rubric, and rounds of inter-visitations from colleagues capturing evidence of student learning in the classroom and through collectively analyzing student work samples.
